MYN 3 Radio Training

The Map Your Neighborhood Owls Nest East (MYN 3) section of Highland Hills gathered recently at the home of John & Cindy Corrigan, which is our MYN meeting place. The purpose of our meeting was to conduct training on FRS radio operations & usage within our MYN. At the meeting, we went over how to operate the radios followed by radio protocol. When everybody got home from the meeting they called into (using their new FRS radio) our MYN meeting place to verify they could make radio contact from home. In addition, they contacted each other's homes within our MYN.

We found that the terrain change between Doe Run and the west end of Owls Nest would only permit the homes at the farthest points away to communicate when on the radio High power setting. Otherwise, the other homes could talk to each other on the Low power setting. Relaying messages between homes also worked well. This was a good radio range check within our neighborhood and allowed people to practice talking on the radio.
